

2022 OSEGC CONVENTION

The "Call:

- 1. The Convention Registration and Schedule of Events forms, Lodging and Directions to Hotel.
- 2. The Board of Directors Meeting is June 13, 3:00 pm to 4:30 pm. Board members need to be present to act on specific business items, the most important being the Budget for 2022-2023.
- 3. Proposed Bylaw Amendment –

Article V Dues and Fees, Section 3 Annual Dues – Amend Item a. to read:

a. Annual dues shall be \$5 for clubs and \$3 per capita through June 30, 2023, and \$5 for clubs and \$5 per capita effective July 1, 2023, on all categories of members including Life Members.

Rationale for the proposed change:

Our General Funds needs have increased substantially by the following increased costs plus others:

- NGC increased dues. We did not increase ours at the time because the treasury was healthy, and we could absorb the increase as a benefit for our clubs. We did not follow up with a later OSFGC increase.
- Costs for transportation, housing, and package plans for our President's required attendance at NGC, Pacific Region and OSFGC meetings have increased. Stipends were increased significantly.
- 3. We adopted and improved our website, which created a new commitment for payment, now significantly higher than at its adoption.
- 4. We increased our insurance coverage with a new policy, and rates on previous coverage increased.
- 5. We hired an accountant to fill out and submit the required federal and state reports for non-profit organizations.
- 6. Printing and mailing costs have risen.

OSFGC Budget Approval Process

OSFGC Board members are reminded of the importance of their attending the preconvention Board Meeting on Monday, June 13, at 3 p.m. at The Mill Casino in North Bend. One of the primary purposes of this meeting is receive a current fiscal report from the OSFGC Treasurer and to review the proposed budget for the 2022-2023 Fiscal Year. Handout material will be available at the meeting and the proposed budget explained. There will be time for questions and/or proposed amendments. The Board will consider the budget at this meeting and will be asked to adopt it as presented (or as amended by the board) as this is one of their primary duties.

Hotel Lodging – BOOK NOW!

Now is the time to make your individual hotel lodging reservations.

Room prices per night are Lodge King Suite \$375, Lodge Double Queen \$160, Lodge Double Queen Bayside \$175, Tower King \$160, Tower Double Queen \$160. Room rates are based on single or double occupancy. Should this be exceeded, there is a charge of \$10 per each additional person in the room. All rooms are subject to an 11% hotel tax. Check-in is at 4:00 p.m.; Check-out time is 11:00 a.m. The hotel room rates have been extended to include Sunday through Wednesday nights.

The Mill Hotel reservations may be made by calling (800) 953-4800. To receive the special discounted rate, <u>call before May 23, 2022</u>, and inform the Reservation Agents that you are attending the OSFGC Convention <u>or mention code 4909</u>.

Reservations may also be booked online at themillcasino.com. From the website select "Book Today" located in the upper right-hand corner, next select "Group Sign In" and enter the code 4909 From there, simply add your dates and select your room type.

DIRECTIONS:

The Mill Casino • Hotel & RV Park, 3201 Tremont Ave, North Bend, OR Driving on Hwy 101 south from Reedsport, travel approximately 24 miles. The Mill will be on your left before Newmark Avenue.

Coming from Coquille, travel OR-42-W connecting with Hwy 101 North. Coquille to The Mill is approximately 20 miles. The Mill Hotel entrance will be on your right, after Newmark Avenue.

From Bandon, drive North on Hwy 101 approximately 26 miles. The Mill Hotel entrance will be on your right, after Newmark Avenue.
