Flower Show General Rules

1. Members of Oregon State Federation of Garden Clubs Inc. and affiliates may enter the show.
2. Horticulture entry cards will be available on the day of the show.
3. Entries in the Design Division must be pre-registered with Design Entries Chairman, **Carole Schuldt at 503-908-8118**. The Design Entries chairman will prepare all entry cards for the design classes and give them to the designer on the day of the show.
4. Each Exhibitor is limited to one entry per class except in the Horticulture Division.
5. All exhibits will be accepted June 12, 2023, from 12:00 pm to 1:30 pm.
6. Judging will begin at 2:00 pm on June 12, 2023. Only the General Chairman, the Classification Chairmen, Judges, and the clerks will be allowed on the show floor during judging. Judging will be by the NGC Standard System of Awarding, HB p 5, and any additions found in the National Garden Club website.
7. The classification Chairmen for each Division checks exhibits for conformity to the schedule prior to judging. Final determination for conformance is the judges' responsibility.
8. The General Chairman and the Classification chairmen must be available during all judging for possible consultations.
9. The decisions of the judges are final, awards will be withheld if not merited.
10. There must be an emphasis on **fresh** plant material. No artificial plant material will be allowed in any division.
11. Noxious weeds and plants on the invasive plant list will be marked so and not to be judged.
12. Portland Judges Council will strive to assure the safety of all items after arrival and placement but is not responsible for any loss or damage to the exhibits.
13. Removal time will be June 14, 2023, at 1:15 pm. If you are unable to personally remove your items, please make arrangements for someone else to do it for you.
