4. Jantzen Beach Information Center

Originally located at the Interstate Bridge Approach I-5

Dedicated October 17, 1952

Not rededicated

Moved to the Center when Bridge and Highway were redone.

Destroyed by a car in 1993 and replaced by the Highway Dept. in 1994

30. Veterans Administration Medical Center

Located Portland at 3710 SW US Veterans Hospital Rd across from the entrance to the center in the Rose Garden.

Located in south east Portland at 11800 SE Mt. Scott Blvd, near the Administration Building, East of I-205
